WOOLWORTHS LTD & ORS V MANNINGHAM CITY COUNCIL REQUEST FOR ATTORNEY-GENERAL'S FIAT

I refer to your letter of 21 December 2010 requesting my fiat to enable your clients to take Supreme Court proceedings to enforce an alleged public charitable trust, and to your subsequent letter of 1 March 2011 asking that I take additional matters into consideration in making a decision on your clients' request.

I have given careful consideration to the request for my fiat and to the matters that you raise. I have also had regard to Gouriet v Union of Post Office Workers [1978] A.C. 435.

Having considered all the circumstances involved, including the time that elapsed and the events that occurred prior to your clients commencing these proceedings and requesting my fiat, and having regard to the public interest, I have decided not to grant my fiat for these proceedings.
